Camp Director



Aline Scott is in her first season as the head coach of the Youngstown State volleyball program.

Scott came to Youngstown having spent eight seasons as a coach in Ohio, including the last three as the head coach at Hiram College. She was previously an assistant coach at Akron for five seasons, and she was the head

coach at Indiana University of Pennsylvania for two years in between.

Scott led Hiram to 61 victories over her three seasons as head coach of the Terriers. She coached a Division III All-American, two all-region student-athletes, a North Coast Athletic Conference Player of the Year and seven All-NCAC honorees. Scott's success came with a horde of newcomers as she welcomed 18 student-athletes to the program in a two-year stretch, including 10 the previous year. Her 2017 squad that won 19 matches had eight freshmen, six of which were Ohio natives.

In her two seasons at IUP, she coached the school's first All-PSAC first-team honoree in seven years. She assembled two talented recruiting classes who went on to lead the Crimson Hawks to 25 wins and their first victory in the NCAA Tournament in 12 years in 2017. Off the court, she largely expanded the program's donor base and led the program to a campus-high 3.73 GPA.

Scott was part of a significant growth period at Akron in her five seasons from 2008-12. The Zips went from finishing 12th in the MAC her first season to a fifthplace finish in her last season in 2012. With Scott as the recruiting coordinator, the Zips were 16-13 overall and 9-7 in the MAC in 2012, which represents their secondhighest win total since 2003.

In her first collegiate coaching experience as a graduate assistant, she helped Central Michigan to a 22-10 mark in 2007 for its first 20-win season in 22 years.

Scott (DosSantos) is a native of Sao Paulo, Brazil, and played collegiately at Marist. She posted 436 kills in 2002, which is the second-highest single-season total in Marist history.





Calaeb Campbell is in his first season as an assistant coach at Youngstown State.

Campbell spent the previous two seasons as an assistant coach at Southeast Missouri where he focused on the Redhawks' liberos and defense.

At SEMO, Campbell helped the Redhawks rank fourth in the Ohio Valley Conference with

16.85 digs per set in his first year. Senior libero Jade Mortimer ranked fourth individually in the conference with 4.61 digs per set and 525 total digs. The Redhawks experienced a four-win improvement in 2017 in what was Campbell's second season.

In addition to serving as the position coach for liberos, defensive specialists and secondary passers, Campbell was charged with overseeing the program's daily operations, practice planning and team travel. He was heavily involved with the design and distribution of the team's gear in addition to helping with recruiting and developing marketing strategies to increase attendance at matches and team camps.

Prior to his two-year stint at Southeast Missouri, Campbell spent 14 months as a volunteer assistant coach at Tennessee Tech. He was responsible for demonstrating and running a variety of team and position-specific drills. He also aided heavily in student-athlete physical fitness. TTU finished the season ranked second in the league in digs per set with 16.60 and held opponents to a .208 hitting percentage, which ranked fifth in the OVC.

Before his experience in the OVC, Campbell coached at the club and high school levels. He was the head coach of the MidTN Volleyball Club out of Murfreesboro, Tenn., and he spent nearly three years as a site director and coach with the Ethos Volleyball Club. His high school experience included a season at Hume-Fogg Academic High School in Nashville, Tenn. and three years assisting the staff at Cookeville High School.

Campbell, a native of Spencer, Tenn., is a 2013 graduate of Tennessee Tech with his Bachelor of Arts degree in Multidisciplinary Studies and Exercise Science.
